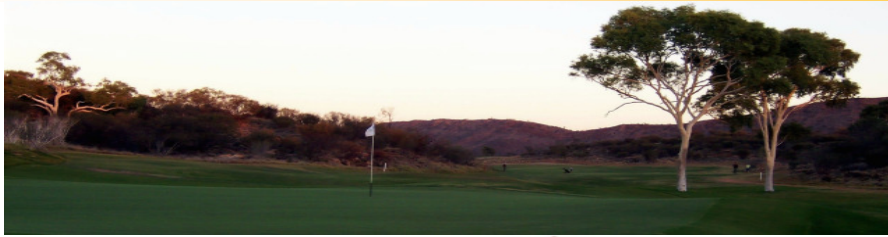

The 2010 Sports Minister's Cup competition between Country and City teams was played at the Darwin Golf Course in mid September.

Right from the outset it was going to be a tough competition for Country as City had named a very strong team and had the home course advantage. Country had trained well under the guidance of coach Steve Tieck in preparation for the event. The Darwin course was in good condition and took a bit of getting used to with much slower greens than in Alice. It was very pleasing to note the improvement in Country's short game – a fact that was commented on by the City captain – Sue McWilliam.

On the Thursday evening both teams and officials were invited to

a welcome reception at Parliament House hosted by Minister Gerry McCarthy (unfortunately, Karl Hampton, the Sports Minister was unable to be there) who told us he lives in Ambrose Avenue in Tennant Creek and does get out onto the Tennant course occasionally for a game with his son.

All the games were played under matchplay rules. Friday and Saturday's format was fourball in the morning and foursomes in the afternoon. After day one City had taken a commanding lead – 8 to Country 0. Overnight Country regrouped and on day 2 picked up one win and a square. Sarah Shacklady and Lyn Tieck beat Sue Wright and Chantelle Hughes in the fourball and Tanya Kirker and Helen Neave squared with Sue McWilliam and Cali Heap in the foursomes.

On Sunday all ten members of the team played single matchplay in handicap order.



Many matches were close, with several going to the last few holes. Winners for Country were Sarah Shacklady against Vicki Purser, Tanya Kirker against Sue Wright and a squared match by Deb Pepper against Sue McWilliam.

The Cup was presented to City at a lunch following the morning's golf and will be housed in Darwin until the 2011 Sports Minister's Cup which will be played in Alice Springs.

Thanks to all team members who gave of their best, to Steve Tieck as coach, to Golf NT who provided rules officials and to the Darwin golfers who helped in many ways.

We recently advised you through a notice on club noticeboards that Golf Australia had made changes to the handicapping rules for 4ball events and handicapping of incomplete rounds. This was part of the Second Package of Changes to the handicapping system – the first package had been implemented in April 2010. However, we have now been advised by Golf Australia that, due to an overwhelming negative response to the Second Package:

*The Board of GA has now decided to suspend the implementation of*

*the Second Package of Changes to the Australian Handicap System for an indefinite period.*

*This period of time will allow GA to: Complete our discussions with the USGA and analyse the outcome of these discussions.*

*In response to the queries and requests from Clubs, provide further detail on the USGA Handicap System. Once the desired detail has been provided and our discussions with the USGA have concluded, we will survey all Australian Clubs and State Associations in order to gain a comprehensive understanding of views regarding the US System.*

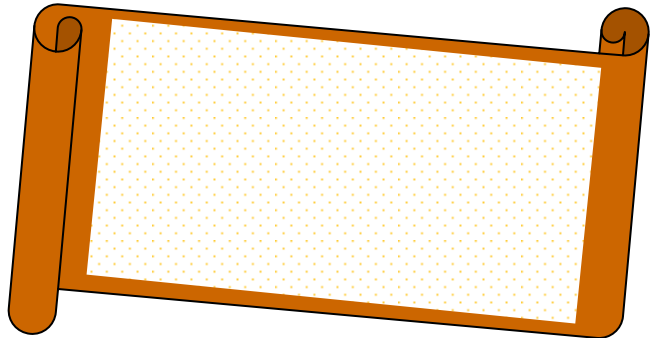
